### Eligibility

#### Cub Scouts

- Must be a registered Cub Scout for the duration of the Cuboree.
- Must have had at least one night away from home on a "Scouting" activity.

#### Venturers & Rovers

- Must be willing to serve in any role in which the Cuboree Director sees fit.

#### Leaders

- Must hold a "Certificate of Adult Membership" as at 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2005.
- Must be willing to serve in any role in which the Cuboree Director sees fit.

#### Adult Supporters

- Must hold a current Police Clearance, which is to be arranged by their Group prior to the application.

#### Cuboree Line Leaders

(Managing a Six within a Cuboree Pack)

- Must hold a "Certificate of Leader of Youth" with experience in the Cub Scout Section.

#### Cuboree Pack Leaders

(Managing the Cubs and 6 other Leaders in a Cuboree Pack. Otherwise known as Pack Akela.)

- Must hold a "Certificate of Leader of Youth" with experience in the Cub Scout Section.
- Must have "Camping Under Canvas" qualifications. Ideally will have attended a previous Cuboree.



## Participant Application

### How To Apply

- Please complete all sections of this application form.
- All applicants (including Cub Scout) must sign the form.
- Parents / Guardians are to sign the permission section. Both persons to sign where possible, or where required under custody provisions.
- Obtain the required signatures as follows:
  - Cub Scouts – Cub Scout Leader and Group Leader
  - Venturer Scouts – Venturer Leader and Group Leader
  - Rovers/Leaders – Group Leader or next appropriate level of commissioner
  - Adult Supporters – Group Leader or next appropriate level of commissioner
- Forward the application form (except this page) together with:
  - A current passport size photograph of the applicant attached to the top of page 2; and
  - The deposit to your Group Leader
  - Group Leaders, please forward The Group summary sheet; and
  - Details of payments.
- **Full payment must be received no later than 31st December 2004.**
- Cheques, bank cheques or postal orders should be made payable to **Scouts Australia – Cuboree 2005.**

### Refund Policy

- 31st December 2004 is the closing date. All applications must be in and full payment made prior to this date.
- If notice of cancellation is received in writing prior to 31st December 2004, a refund of all monies paid to date, less \$25.00 will be forwarded.
- If notice of cancellation is received in writing between 31st December 2004 and 24<sup>th</sup> March 2005, a refund of all monies paid to date, less \$50.00 will be forwarded.
- No monies will be refunded after 24th March 2005, except in exceptional circumstances (eg. Family deaths or sickness) as approved by the Cuboree Director. Requests must be accompanied by a Doctor's Certificate, if applicable.
- All notifications of cancellation and requests for refund must be in writing.

### Substitution Policy

- No substitutions of Youth or Adults will be accepted after 22nd February 2005. All data entry will cease after this date.
- An administration fee of \$25.00 is applicable to all substitutions prior to 22nd February 2005.
- All substitutions **MUST** be declared or the participant will not be covered by insurance.
- Any Youth or Adults on the site, who have not been "officially accepted" by receipt of application and full payment will not be covered by insurance.
- Applicants must not be "unofficially substituted" for another to avoid the refund policy.

### Menu

A well balanced diet will be provided. Please ensure you write the details of issues affecting your diet on the Medical Details part of the form. Simple variations may be able to be arranged with Sub Camp catering teams. Should your needs vary substantially, you may be asked to bring your own food. Storage, including refrigeration, will be provided within the sub camps.
